JUNIOR DOMESTIC AWARDS 2020

Awards are open to players and referees U10-U18 unless otherwise stated.

Junior Domestic Player of the Year

Given to a male and female player of any age playing in the U14-U18 domestic competition who shows commitment to basketball and SBA.

Things to consider when nominating a player for this award:

- Awarded not only for skill but also for commitment to basketball and SBA.
- Demonstrates good sportsmanship by being a supportive teammate and generous player.
- Regularly helps at Mini ball either with bench, refereeing or assisting U10 teams.
- Seeks additional training opportunities such as skills clinics.
- Attends senior games to support the club.
- Is generally helpful and friendly around the stadium.
- This person should be a good role model for younger players.

Junior Domestic Referee of the Year

Open to referees of any age who regularly referee Junior games.

The criteria set out for this award is:

- Shows a commitment to refereeing and lifting the standard of basketball at SBA.
- Demonstrates a desire to improve by attending relevant development opportunities.
- Has shown progression and improvement as a referee throughout the year.

Mini-baller of the year Male & Female

Given to a top age male and female player graduating from the U12 domestic competition who shows commitment to basketball and SBA.

Things to consider when nominating a player for this award:

Mini-ball Referee of the year

Open to any junior referee who regularly referees Mini-ball games.

The criteria set out for this award is:

- Shows commitment to refereeing and assists younger players to develop their knowledge of the game.
- Demonstrates a desire to improve by seeking feedback and attending relevant development opportunities.
- Has shown progression and improvement as a referee throughout the year.
- Is generally helpful and friendly around the stadium

Male and Female Tigers Spirit Award

Open to all junior players in U12's-Under18's

The criteria set out for this award is:

- Encouragement to all players.
- Team Player.
- Great attitude on court.

Aussie Hoops Graduating Player

Open to all Aussie Hoopers who have played in 4 consecutive seasons of Aussie hoops and will be graduating to Under12's competition.

Junior Domestic Coach of the year

Open to all coaches of domestic teams in U12's-U18's.

The criteria set out for this award is:

- Shows commitment to domestic team.
- Encourages and supports all members of the team.
- Gives all players on their team, fair court time.
- Displays respectful, positive behavior to opposing team and officials,

Junior Club Person of the Year

To be awarded to the person who demonstrates a high level of commitment to the success of SBA Junior Program (domestic and/or representative). This award is open to adults who regularly help and assist SBA.

The criteria set out for this award is:

- i. Shows passion for SBA.
- ii. Is friendly and helpful.
- iii. Often goes above and beyond in helping SBA.

Things to consider when nominating a person for this award:

- This person will have contributed to SBA consistently throughout the year. Examples of this include but are not limited to holding a committee position, assisting with working bees, managing a representative team, coaching a domestic team.

SENIOR DOMESTIC AWARDS

Senior Domestic Referee of the Year

Open to referees of any age who regularly referee Junior games.

The criteria set out for this award is:

- Shows a commitment to refereeing and lifting the standard of basketball at SBA.
- Demonstrates a desire to improve by attending relevant development opportunities.

Has shown progression and improvement as a referee throughout the year.

Senior Club Person of the Year

To be awarded to the person who demonstrates a high level of commitment to the success of SBA Senior Program (domestic and/or or representative). This award is open to adults who regularly help and assist SBA.

The criteria set out for this award is:

- i. Shows passion for SBA.
- ii. Is friendly and helpful.
- iii. Often goes above and beyond in helping SBA.

Things to consider when nominating a person for this award:

- This person will have contributed to SBA consistently throughout the year. Examples of this include but are not limited to holding a committee position, assisting with working bees, managing a representative team, coaching a domestic team.

ASSOCIATION WIDE AWARDS

These awards are presented at the SBA Representative Presentation night.

Representative Coach of the Year

To be awarded to a Representative Coach who demonstrates commitment to their team and SBA.

The criteria set out for this award is:

- i. Shows a passion for basketball and commitment to their team.
- ii. Builds a strong rapport and gets the best from their players.
- iii. Demonstrates good sportsmanship on the bench when representing SBA.

The Kane Gattringer Tiger Award

To be awarded to a player (domestic and/or representative) who is a genuine team player with a tenacious, passionate, and competitive nature. This player is someone who tries to lift their team by going the extra step for their teammates and sharing a good sense of humour. This award is for a player who displays true Tiger team spirit on and off the court.

Things to consider when nominating a player for this award:

- Awarded to someone who makes a difference to their team and/or the SBA community.
- Demonstrates a passion for SBA and their team as well as displaying good sportsmanship.
- This player will be a supportive teammate with sense of humour.

JUNIOR REPRESENTATIVE AWARDS

Awards are open to players and referees U12-U18 unless otherwise stated. These awards are presented at the SBA Representative Presentation night.

Junior Representative Male and Female Player of the Year

To be awarded to the junior male and female players who have achieved success with their representative development beyond SBA in that year.

The criteria set out for this award is:

- i. This includes being selected for BNSW development opportunities Country Tour/Slam team, TAP, NITP or above.
- ii. Must be a player in the U16 or U18 age group.

Things to consider when nominating a player for this award:

- The player must demonstrate good sportsmanship.
- Ideally the player gives back to the Association by being generally helpful and positive around the stadium at home and while travelling.
- Where competition is close for the award, we will look for players who add value to the Association (examples of this include but are not limited to: coaching a younger representative or domestic team, joining a committee such as fundraising, supporting the domestic competition by doing bench duty, refereeing domestic competition).

Junior Representative Referee of the Year

To be awarded to the junior representative referee of any age who has achieved success with their development as a representative referee in that year.

The criteria set out for this award is:

- i. This includes being selected to referee at a representative level beyond SBA.
- ii. Shown commitment to developing as a referee.

Representative Graduating Players

To be awarded to representative players who have represented SBA in every age division during their Junior playing career.

The criteria set out for this award is:

- i. Player must have played in every age division (U12, U14, U16, U18) for SBA;
- ii. Player must play top age U18 as their final year (Note: In the event that SBA does not have a rep team in a particular year to enable a player to play top age u18, the player needs to have demonstrated commitment through attending SBA representative trials as if there was a team available.

The Ryan Walsh Memorial Trophy for Representative Team of the Year

This trophy is to be awarded to the representative team that demonstrates true team spirit.

Things to consider when nominating a team for this award:

- Display a high degree of commitment to train together, stay together and play together.
- Demonstrate a supportive and collegiate team culture.
- Display positive behavior and sportsmanship when playing.
- Does not necessarily have to be the most successful team.

SENIOR REPRESENTATIVE AWARD

Senior Representative Male and Female Player of the Year

To be awarded to the Senior male and female players who have achieved success within the Senior Representative Program in that year.

The criteria set out for this award is:

- i. Includes being selected for a BNSW Waratah League Award – such as All Star 5, Players of the Year, Top Point Scorer etc.

Things to consider when nominating a player for this award:

- The player must demonstrate good sportsmanship.
- Ideally the player gives back to the Association by being generally helpful and positive around the stadium, at home and while travelling.
- Where competition is close for the award, we will look for players who add value to the Association (examples of this include but are not limited to: coaching a younger representative or domestic team, joining a committee such as fundraising, supporting the domestic competition by doing bench duty, refereeing domestic competition).
